### Goal Statements

1. Destination Park:
  - Design and create a destination park and playground that serves ages 2-102 and all physical abilities.
2. Design the Heart:
  - Create a unique destination that distinguishes itself from surrounding outdoor experiences.
  - Identify and brand how the Heart of Monument will serve as the "Heart" of outdoor active play within the region.
3. Community Engagement:
  - Ensure the community has been informed, engaged, and communicated with regarding thoughts, feedback and desires for a community park.
  - Utilize a variety of methods to reach a broad spectrum of users and community members.
4. Promote Safe Exploration and Physical Activity:
  - Create a safe and open park and playground environment that fosters the freedom to explore.
  - Incorporate exercise equipment and machinery to encourage physical activity and free play.
5. Facilitate Independent Play and Inclusivity:
  - Design a comfortable and safe playground that allows all to play independently.
6. Establish Safe, Defined Spaces:
  - Create a strategic flow of space that incorporates seating, strolling, and active play for a pleasing experience for all patrons.
7. Quality of Playground Equipment:
  - Select high quality large and small scale playground equipment pieces that reflect safety and accessibility.
  - Equipment and amenities will need to reflect the priorities and vision of The Monument Community for future generations.
8. Short and Long Term Maintenance
  - Carefully select equipment, ground surfacing, landscaping, and all other facets with maintenance in mind.
  - Maintenance on a short term and long term basis will need to be considered in design and selection.
